

Policy on Waivers for HON 491 and HON 495

Under certain circumstances students may be allowed a waiver of some coursework requirements for Upper Division Honors.

HON 491

Waivers may be provided for students who can demonstrate the following:

1. successful completion of the Selected Studies Program, earning at least Sophomore Honors
2. successful completion of at least one semester of Study Abroad, National Student Exchange, or International Exchange;
3. successful completion of a similar or equivalent "breadth experience," which may include a multidisciplinary upper division or graduate seminar, or other experience with academic focus

If you think you qualify, please submit a signed petition accompanied by formal evidence of equivalent coursework or experience.

HON 495

Students may be allowed a waiver for HON 495 if they can demonstrate that they have received rigorous training which culminates in the preparation of a proposal for research and creative work. This proposal must be presented at the Spring Symposium or Fall Forum and a written version must be submitted to the Honors Program. Students in Psychology may substitute HON 439, taken with Professor Lorey Takahashi, as long as they also present a proposal at the Spring Symposium or Fall Forum and submit a written version to the Honors Program

If you think you qualify, please submit a signed petition accompanied by formal evidence of equivalent coursework or experience.
