Agreement to serve as Advisor on a Senior Honors Project

The Senior Honors Project is a two-semester sequence of research or creative work accomplished independently by the student under the direction of a faculty member. The sequence normally involves one semester of research or other form of preparation, such as planning and rehearsal, and one semester of writing or creative work. The project will be normally related to the student's major field of study, though in some cases the advisor may be from a different field, in which case we will later ask that advisor and chair of the major department sign a memorandum of understanding.
